

## **Kid Safe Overview**

### **Player safety – rules are clear and documented in the Kid Safe document**

- ✓ Players – jewelry, shin guards, shatterproof glasses, should wear cleats. Coaches are to check prior to every game.
- ✓ Field and goals – check to make sure goals are safe, fields are clean
- ✓ Clothing – players wear uniforms, coaches wear coach shirt

### **In case of injury or first aid**

- ✓ Call for help at 215-887-1600
- ✓ Remain calm, keep player still
- ✓ Use first aid kit – all coaches at EP and Ogontz have one. There is one in the snack stand at CAA.
- ✓ Bleeding – coach to use glove, player cannot play

### **Be smart**

- ✓ Don't touch a player
- ✓ Do not be left alone with player remind parents that it their child and their responsibility to be there, in particular if their child gets hurt.
- ✓ No bad language by coach, player, referee or spectator is permitted
- ✓ No one is permitted to talk to the referees except the coaches
- ✓ No one is permitted to argue with a referee or dispute a call, period.
- ✓ Do not have a coach who has not been kid-safed.
- ✓ Lookout for strangers, you are authorized to question anyone you believe is suspicious

### **The Kid-Safe process**

- ✓ Fill out forms
- ✓ Forms sent to EPYSA and for criminal check
- ✓ Volunteers must be educated on Kid safe stuff
- ✓ Volunteers get shirt and must wear to practices and games
